In which habitat does it live (for example, woodlands, desert, oceans or rainforest)?

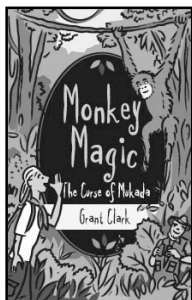
Give some more details about your species. For example, what does it eat? How many years does it live? How many babies do they have at a time? How big do they grow?
